Instructions for Extended Studies Students

Thank you for registering for a Colorado Mesa University Extended Studies course. Courses offered through the Extended Studies program are designed to meet the educational and training needs of professionals and are flexibly-scheduled to accommodate busy and demanding lives.

Course Registration

Each time you take an extended studies course, you'll complete the registration form. Please fill out the entire form and answer all questions. Leaving a question blank could delay your admission and enrollment in the course.

Tuition Payment and Billing

Tuition for extended studies courses is structured to be affordable and accessible. Tuition is due at the time of registration. Please check the registration form to determine if payment should be made to the College or to the coordinating agency. You may pay by cash, check or credit card.

Grade Reports

Your instructor is responsible for entering your final grades once your course has completed. This course is graded Pass/Fail. Successful completion of the course will result in a grade of P on your transcript. Final grade reports are no longer sent to participants; you must access your grades online. Final grades will be available approximately one week after the end of the semester.
